THE ONLY MUSEUM FOR CHILDREN'S ART IN SCHLESWIG-HOLSTEIN CELEBRATES IT'S BIRTHDAY!  
THE ASSOCIATION ART FOR FISHING THEREFORE EXPANDS THE COOPERATION WITH THE DAY CARE CENTERS IN FLENSBURG, STEINBERGKIRCHE, SCHLESWIG AND GELTING.

On Sunday, October 13, 2024 the children's art club Angeln - Schleswig-Holstein's only museum for art by children - celebrated it's birthday: one year of existence.

On this occasion, the initiator of the museum, Ingrid Roosen-Trinks, head of the association Kunst für Angeln, has expanded the cooperation with the Protestant daycare centers in the district of Schleswig-Flensburg.

The cooperation with the daycare centers in Flensburg, Scheggerott and Gelting was so successful that it is now being expanded. New on board are the daycare center "Hornbrunnen" in Schleswig and the daycare center "Siebenstern" in Steinbergkirche.

The daycare centers thus intensify their educational offer in the field of art. "Contact with works of art by contemporary artists is very enriching for both the educational professionals and the children.

We are pleased to be able to support the low-threshold access to art for all." says Katja Bär, Head of the Protestant daycare centers Schleswig-Flensburg.

More than 100 works of art - from drawings to paintings and sculptures - created by children from Flensburg and Angeln aged between 3 and 6 years old, can be seen on the Wittkielhof from 13 October.

Original works of art by Stefan Balkenhol, Katrin Kampmann and Thorsten Brinkmann were used as templates this year. What creative work the 3 - 6 year olds have been inspired to do is really worth seeing. Until November 10, 2024 to be seen in the CHILDREN'S ART CLUB ANGELN on the Wittkielhof!

Ingrid Roosen-Trinks, founder and director of the association KUNST FÜR ANGELN, and initiator of the children's art club Angeln:

„A heart felt project comes true! The creativity of the 3 - 6 year old children is incredible and the quality of the children's art so high that 6 of the children's works exhibited in the spring exhibition were acquired by adult visitors.

Of course only after consultation with the children and parents - but the feedback was amazing and the enthusiasm of our visitors remarkable! It is therefore a particular pleasure that this creative cooperation is now being extended to other kindergartens in Angeln."

## ONE-YEAR EXISTENCE

In October 2023, the association KUNST FÜR ANGELN and the CHILDREN'S ART CLUB ANGELN, opened an exclusive exhibition to showcase the creative results such as paintings, drawings and sculptures of elementary school children and kindergarten children in northern Schleswig-Holstein, in 130 sqm exhibition space.

The children's art is based on original works of art from the collection of Roosen-Trinks, the founder of the association KUNST FÜR ANGELN.

The originals are lent to the participants free of charge.

In addition to daycare centres, primary schools also other schools in Angeln receive loans of works of art to enrich art lessons and to inspire children to create their own works of art. In addition, Kunst für Angeln at the Wittkielhof, organizes workshops for children aged 5 - 14 years with the Children's Art Club Angeln twice a year.

#### FREE WORKSHOPS FOR CHILDREN

All workshops take place in the rooms of KUNST FÜR ANGELN e.V., are free and are led by artists who are with at least 2 works of art in the collection Roosen-Trinks. These works of art serve as examples for the kids inspiring to draw and craft.

#### CHILDREN GUIDE ADULTS THROUGH THE EXHIBITION

Another highlight: 8-year-old Clara and 10-year-old Armin are the "heads" of our KINDER KUNST CLUBS ANGELN. And the two of them will personally take us adults through the exhibition from October! "

The exhibition started on Sunday, 13 October 2024 and is open to the public until 10 November 2024.
