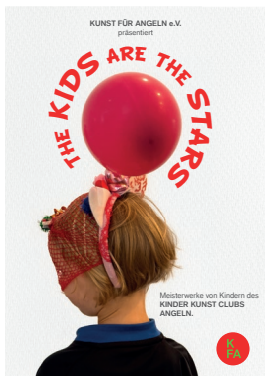
The non-profit association Kunst für Angeln e.V. warmly invites you to the opening of Germany's largest public exhibition of children's art to date. On September 28, 2025, 400 artworks by children aged 3 to 14 will be presented at WITTKIELHOF on an exhibition space of 400 square meters.

The artworks were created during creative workshops organized and supervised by Kunst für Angeln e.V. The aim of the project is to provide a platform for young talents and to highlight the importance of creativity and artistic expression in child development.

"With this exhibition, we want to showcase the diversity and expressive power of children's creativity while creating a space for encounter and exchange," says Ingrid Roosen-Trinks, Chairwoman of Kunst für Angeln e.V.

Henrik Becker, artist and curator of the exhibition, adds: "We are presenting imaginative, bold, and often surprising works by children, most of which were created in workshops with various artists. In the free play with colors, shapes, and ideas, childlike curiosity meets artistic impulses — and something entirely unique emerges: art with personality."

The exhibition will be open from September 28 to October 19, 2025, and welcomes visitors of all ages. Admission is free.



To accompany the exhibition, the book "The Kids are the Stars" will be published. It features selected works by the young artists, impressions from the workshops, and background stories about the project.

This lovingly designed publication impressively demonstrates how much imagination, courage, and expressive power children use to shape their world — and at the same time documents a unique art event in northern Germany. A heartfelt book about the power of childhood creativity — and about what can arise when children are given the space to express themselves artistically.

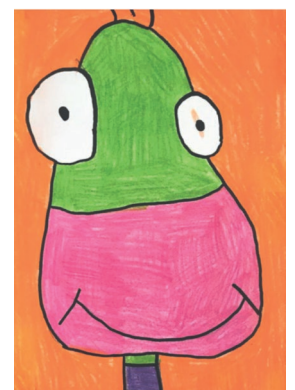
