Kunst für Angeln e.V. presents Germany's largest children's art exhibition Opening on September 28, 2025, in northern Schleswig-Holstein

On September 28, 2025, WITTKIELHOF will host Germany's largest public children's art exhibition to date: 400 works by children aged 3 to 14 displayed across 400 square meters.

The works were created in workshops organized by Kunst für Angeln e.V., which offered young talents space for imagination, courage, and creative expression. The aim of the project is to make creativity in childhood development visible and to promote interaction.

"Here we are showing imaginative, bold, and often surprising works created in the free play of colors, shapes, and ideas – art with personality," says curator Henrik Becker.

"With this exhibition, we want to make the diversity and expressive power of children's creativity visible, while also creating a space for encounter and exchange," says Ingrid Roosen-Trinks, Chairwoman of Kunst für Angeln e.V.

Closing Event (Open House): Sunday, October 19, 2025, from 12:00 p.m.

The lovingly designed book brings together selected works by the young artists, impressions from the workshops, and background stories about the project – a tribute to the power of children's creativity.
